









Barco Clickshare in a meeting room

Steps	Description	Activity
Turn on the touch panel	Tap the touch panel.	
Select type of meeting	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• “Virtual meeting” – is used for meetings/exams where videoconferencing is needed.• “Just use monitor” – is used for a meeting where you only need to use the screen for presentations, and with no participants at other locations.	
Connect USB Dongle	Share content by inserting the USB dongle that belongs to the Clickshare.	
Install program	Install the program for the type of computer you are using by double-clicking the icon.	



Share content	You are now ready to share the content from your computer on the screen. This is also shared with any participants via videoconferencing.
